



# Can You Afford a Dog?

Many people rush into buying a puppy on impulse without considering the actual costs involved. When taking on a dog you also assume a duty of care to the dog to keep it fed, trained, warm, safe and physically healthy. This is a 12 year plus financial commitment that should not be taken lightly. Have you realistically assessed how a dog will impact your budget?

**Outlined below is a list of the costs involved in your puppies first year of life:**

Intestinal Worming Tablets	\$25.00
Flea and Tick Prevention	\$15.00
Council Registration Fees	\$80.00
Puppy School	\$120.00
Obedience Course	\$130.00
Food	\$520.00
Toys	\$30.00
Collar and Lead	\$30.00
Car Harness	\$50.00
Crate	\$60.00
Play Pen or Kennel	\$100.00
Kong	\$25.00
ID Tag	\$15.00
Sundries (Brush, Bowls, Shampoo etc)	\$100.00
Bedding	\$50.00

## Can You Afford a Dog?

Once you get past the first year you there are ongoing costs. Consider the following annual costs:

Description	Approx. Cost
Health Check (minimum of annually)	\$45.00
Vaccination	\$80.00
Heartworm Prevention (annual vaccination)	\$75.00
Intestinal Worming Tablets	\$25.00
Flea and Tick Prevention	\$15.00
Council Registration Fees (assuming dog is desexed)	\$25.00
Food	\$520.00
Toys	\$20.00
Sundries (replace collars, leads, shampoo etc)	\$100.00
<b>Total - Not including initial purchase of puppy</b>	<b>Approx. \$965.00</b>

Over the life of your dog you can expect to pay around \$13000 just to keep your dog!
